

JSCC Vehicle Passport Application Notes

This must be filled in by the inspecting scrutineer, but please take note

Vehicle Details:

Make sure your chassis number on the bulkhead is legible.

Date/Year of Manufacture: Suggest (1997-1999 for Mk1, 2000 – 2004 for Mk2) if you're not sure.

Engine details:

Citroen, 4 cylinder, 1587cc

Fuel Tank Details:

Type: Either ATL or Fuel Safe Safety Cell (Homologation numbers: ATL 565/Fuel Safe CL100)

Protected

ROPS Detail:

Manufacturer: Custom Cages

Drawing Number: 12

ID plate (found on either backstay or bottom of A/B pillar) should give Job Number: Rxxxx and Cage

Number: CSMX/xxxx or CS/xxxxc

If no RAC/MSA Certificate Number or ID plate is available, please allow scrutineer to measure the cage to ensure conformity to Appendix J (253) – as per JSCC regs

Hologated Equipment:

Check harness and seat dates. Remember seats only have a 5 year life.

Fire extinguishers need to be in date and serviced every 2 years

Fuel tanks need to be in date

Seals:

For 2018, JSCC cars will require cage seals. Please contact Dave Beecroft on 07970 919371 or davidbeecroft@icloud.com to assign a seal to your chassis number.

Photographs:

You must supply

- ¾ front and right
- ¾ left and rear
- Engine bay from front

From experience, the scrutineers prefer to submit the Passport Application forms digitally, please submit the pictures in a digital format either by email to your scrutineer or preferably on a USB memory stick at the inspection.

Cost: The cost of a vehicle passport is about £43 – you will be issued with a receipt, which will be accepted as the log book, until your actual logbook arrives. KEEP IT SAFE
